

## MSM's Dr. Toyosi Adekeye selected to 2016 Community Based Participatory Research Partnership Academy

Dr. Toyosi Adekeye, Community Health and Preventive Medicine assistant professor and director of the Community Health Leadership Program, Community Voices: Healthcare for the Underserved, at the Satcher Health Leadership Institute (SHLI), and community partner Dr. Joseph Takon, CEO of the Redeemer's Medical Center, were selected through a competitive review process to participate in the 2016 Community Based Participatory Research (CBPR) Partnership Academy.

The Partnership Academy is an integrated one-year research education program in which twelve community-academic teams from across the country engage in an intensive week-long CBPR course and ongoing mentored learning activities throughout the year.

The CBPR Partnership Academy is funded by the National Institutes of Health and is facilitated by community and academic partners involved in the Detroit Community-Academic Urban Research Center and affiliated CBPR partnerships at the University of Michigan School of Public Health, Ann Arbor, MI.
