Vicki Carew joined Morehouse School of Medicine as the Office of Institutional Advancement's Director of Unit Development on December 7, 2015. Prior to joining MSM, Ms. Carew served as the Executive Director of Institutional Advancement and Executive Director of Georgia Perimeter College Foundation. She led the GPC Foundation's development efforts that supported the college's strategic priorities, leveraging private support and effectively managing almost \$100 million in assets.

Ms. Carew's long-term commitment to philanthropic access, education, community engagement and youth development have been evident in both her professional and personal life. She spent seven years with Project GRAD Atlanta, where she developed the organization's national model for college support, and led retention efforts for students enrolled at over 70 colleges and universities. Prior to that, she served at Morehouse College where she championed the institution's initial service learning initiative, and its community service efforts.
