

MSM's Dr. Anekwe Onwuanyi & Jo Ann Cross Participate in Karolinska University's Heart Failure Preceptorship Program

In March, Morehouse School of Medicine (MSM)'s [Dr. Anekwe Onwuanyi](#) and **Jo Ann Cross, RN**, were invited to participate in the international meeting of the Heart Failure Preceptorship Program at the [Karolinska University Hospital](#) in Stockholm, Sweden. Their participation in the preceptorship program will advance the mission of MSM by providing further opportunities for MSM students, residents, fellows and faculty in preceptor programs and research collaborations with Karolinska University Hospital.

Karolinska University Hospital System, one of Europe's largest hospitals, has 1.5 million outpatient visits per year, 1,700 beds and 16,000 employees. The Karolinska Institute is ranked as a top three medical university in Europe and top 10 globally. A contingent of guests from Karolinska visited the Grady Heart Failure Program in 2014 and the knowledge that they gained during their visit to Atlanta has been implemented. MSM was publicly credited for its contribution to their program at the international meeting in March 2017.
