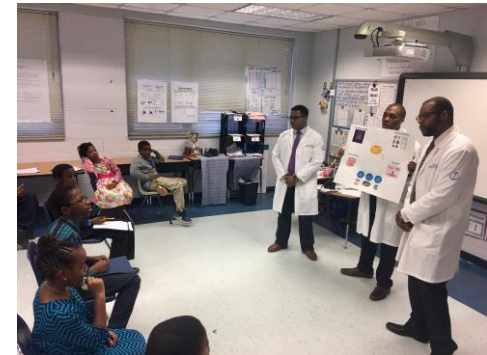
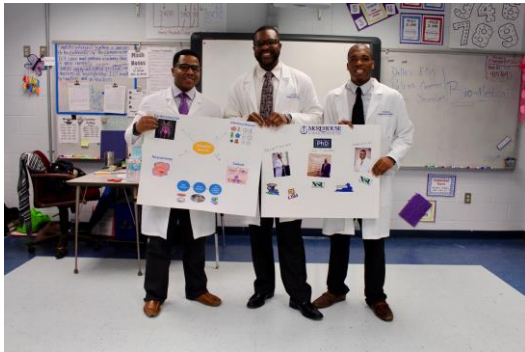


MSM GEBS Students Participate in Career Day at W.J. Scott Elementary
