Christopher Taylor joined Morehouse School of Medicine as the Director of Major Gifts, Office of Institutional Advancement, on May 9, 2016.

Mr. Taylor brings more than 22 years of fundraising experience to MSM through his work with the Lipscomb University, University of Louisville Health Sciences Center and College of Business, the University of Kentucky, the University of Florida, and Washington State University. During his tenure, he managed the increase in overall fundraising for the U of L College of Business from \$1.2 million annually to \$5.1 million over a three-year period. Prior to his appointment at MSM, Taylor was the Assistant Vice President for Development at Lipscomb University College of Business.

During his career, Taylor also successfully secured over \$2 million in support of endowed faculty positions across various units at the University of Kentucky, including Medicine, Nursing, Engineering and Business; raised over \$2 million in annual fund gifts within two years for the University of Florida College of Medicine in support of student scholarships; and assisted in developing the first Corporate Associates Program at Washington State University.

Mr. Taylor holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science from the University of Idaho and an Executive Certificate in Medical Management from the University of Kentucky.
