Important Early Voting Information

Early voting began in Georgia on Monday, October 17th! Early voting times and locations vary by county. Please see below for more information.

Before you go to vote, please do your research! We aren't just voting for President and VP. We are also voting for state and local officials, as well as 4 proposed amendments to the Georgia Constitution, and some local stuff in Atlanta for MARTA expansion, etc.

Many of you are registered in Fulton County, so the next couple links will be for you. Early voting hours are from 7am-7pm Mon-Fri for the next couple weeks until Friday, November 4th. There are also early voting hours on the weekends also listed at these links.
