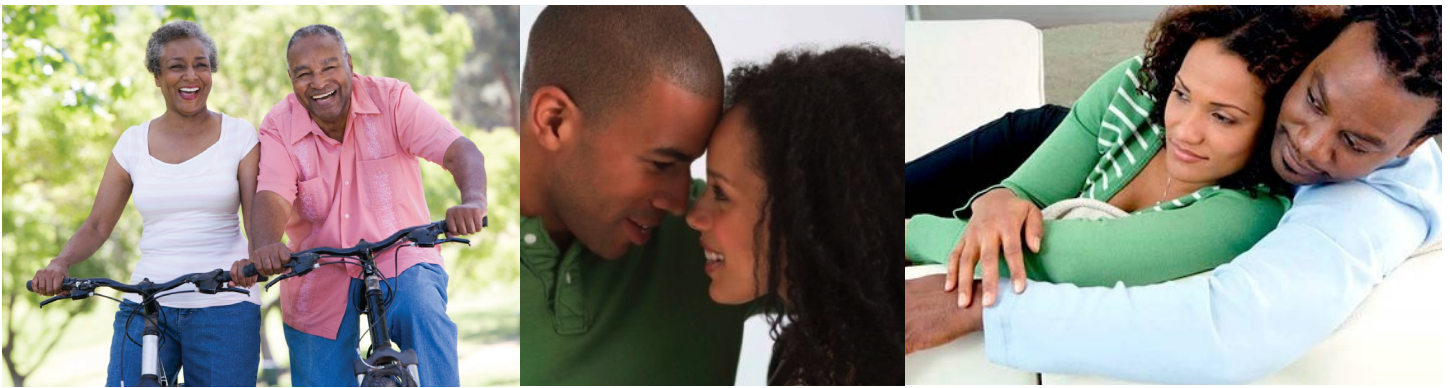


Nutri-Genomic Study

Eligibility Requirement:

- Are 18-70 years of age and self-identify as Black/African-American
- Have high blood pressure or have been told by your doctor that your blood pressure is high
- Consider yourself to be overweight or on the heavier side

- Compensation for time and travel
